SANTOS UPDATE – June 2016

Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area (PEL 238)

Time frames are indicative as schedules are dependent on factors such as approval times, weather and rig availability.

References to pilot wells are grouped in well sets as follows: Bibblewindi East includes Bibblewindi 12 – 21 & 27 - 29; Bibblewindi West includes Bibblewindi 22 – 26. Bibblewindi 9 Spot includes Bibblewindi 3 – 9; Dewhurst North includes Dewhurst 6, 22 – 25; Dewhurst South includes Dewhurst 26 – 29

Decommissioning of wells:

- There are no plug and abandon activities planned for June

Workovers:

- There are no workover activities planned for June

Drilling of exploration core holes:

- There are no core hole activities planned for June

Pilot wells:

- Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst South and Tintfield pilot wells are on-line

Leewood:

- Leewood Phase 2 project construction is progressing to schedule

Other work:

- Continuation of rehabilitation (irrigation and soil conditioning) at salt impacted legacy sites – currently Bibblewindi with future work scheduled for Bohena 2, Bohena 3, Bohena 4, Bohena 7 and Bohena South
- Continued monitoring activities for regional baseline groundwater assessment including information from selected NSW DPI Groundwater Observation Bores
- The Wilga Park Power Station is on-line

Other:

- The Forestry Corporation of NSW 2015 Fox Baiting Program for Pilliga East and Bibblewindi State forests had 43 bait stations in proximity to 40km of State Forest roads with a 68% uptake rate.
- The first meeting of the CSIRO Gas Industry Social and Environmental Research Alliance (GISERA) Regional Research Advisory Committee (RRAC) for NSW was held in Narrabri on 26 May 2016. The RRAC is responsible for preparing the Annual Research Program and budget each year, advising on science direction and gaps and technical issues, approving research projects and reporting on performance against KPIs. Representation on the committee is from CSIRO, State Government, Industry (Santos and AGL) and four independent members.
