About the CCC

The Narrabri Gas Project Community Consultative Committee (CCC) brings together community, industry, local and state governments to explore and discuss issues relating to the exploration and extraction of CSG in the Gunnedah Basin.

Chaired by the NSW Land and Water Commissioner, members of the dialogue include Narrabri Shire Councillors and officers, independent community members, senior Santos representatives and senior agency officers from the Office of Coal Seam Gas (OCSG), the Division of Resources and Energy (DRE), the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA), the NSW Office of Water (NOW) and the Department of Planning and Environment (DP&E).

Santos provided their monthly operations update. Santos also stated that the Santos Fire Management Plan will be finalised by the end of June, 2015 and will distributed to CCC members at the July NGP CCC.

DRE provided an update on the Leewood Produced Water Treatment and Beneficial Reuse Project - Phase 2. It was explained that all submissions received were available on the Digital Imaging of Geological System (DIGS) online archive. It was also noted that the BTEX: Questions and Answers Information Sheet be forwarded to committee members. The information sheet outlines the investigations following notification from AGL on 27 January 2015 that traces of BTEX compounds had been detected in routine flowback water sampling.

The Santos Drilling Completions Manager, NSW & QLD Operations, provided a comprehensive drilling presentation. This presentation will be provided to NGP CCC members following NGP CCC #7.

Also discussed were the findings of the EPA regarding investigations into two incidents: the EPA is issuing Pollution Reduction Programs that will be attached to Santos' Environment Protection Licence - one for each incident.

The NSW EPA board attended the NGP CCC as part of their regional board meeting, with each of the NGP CCC delegates having the opportunity to voice the concerns of the organisations they represent. The EPA board also had the opportunity to outline both the Board and EPA position on gas exploration and production regulation and compliance.

It was also decided that questions tabled during CCC meetings be forwarded to all members of the committee.
