

### Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area (PEL 238)

#### Environmental Impact Statement (EIS):

- Santos submitted our detailed response to submissions (RTS) on the EIS to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) in April 2018.
- The RTS carefully considered the public submissions and confirmed the Project can be developed safely and sustainably.

#### Western Slopes Pipeline:

- APA Group is preparing an Environmental Impact Statement for the Western Slopes Pipeline which would connect natural gas from the proposed Narrabri Gas Project to the Moomba-Sydney Pipeline.

#### Drilling of exploration core holes, workovers and decommissioning of wells:

- No activities planned for August.

#### Pilot wells:

- Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst South and Tintfield pilot wells are on-line.

#### Leewood:

- The lucerne crop at Leewood is not currently being irrigated. Produced water is being stored in purpose built holding ponds.

#### Other work:

- Approval has been received from the Department of Planning and Environment to allow gas from the Dewhurst South 26-31 and Tintfield pilot wells to be beneficially used in the Wilga Park Power Station. This gas will be used to generate power for the region and substantially reduce flaring.
- Rehabilitation is continuing at legacy sites, including revegetation activities at Bibblewindi.
