Time frames are indicative as schedules are dependent on factors such as approval times, weather and rig availability.

Decommissioning of wells:

• There are no plug and abandon activities planned for November

Workovers:

 There are no workover activities planned for November

Drilling of exploration core holes:

 There are no core hole activities planned for November

Pilot wells:

- Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst North, Dewhurst South and Tintsfield pilot wells are on-line
- Lease construction for Dewhurst 30 and 31 is underway in preparation for drilling of the two pilot wells
- The Review of Environmental Factors (REF) for the Dewhurst 32-37 pilot wells and Bibblewindi 34 core hole has been postponed until 2015

Leewood:

Construction activities at Leewood for Phase 1 are complete

- Wilga Park Power Station remains in operation
- Bibblewindi Pond 3 clean-out is complete
