## SANTOS UPDATE – October 2014 Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area

Time frames are indicative as schedules are dependent on factors such as approval times, weather and rig availability.

### **Decommissioning of wells:**

 There are no plug and abandon activities planned for October

#### Workovers:

 The workover program for the Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West and Dewhurst pilot wells has been completed and the workover rig has demobilised

#### **Drilling of exploration core holes:**

 There are no core hole activities planned for October

#### **Pilot wells:**

- There are no pilot well drilling activities planned for October
- Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst North and Tintsfield pilot wells are on-line
- Dewhurst South pilot will be commissioned in October

## Leewood:

 Construction activities at Leewood are now complete and construction equipment and facilities have been decommissioned from site

#### Other work:

- Lease preparation for the Dewhurst 30 and 31 pilot wells is scheduled to commence in early November
- Wilga Park Power Station remains in operation
- Clean out of Bibblewindi Pond 3 continues
- Santos staff and contractors are undertaking Bushfire Awareness Training, a NSW Rural Fire Service accredited training course
