SANTOS UPDATE – October 2016 Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area (PEL 238)

Time frames are indicative as schedules are dependent on factors such as approval times, weather and rig availability.

References to pilot wells are grouped in well sets as follows: Bibblewindi East includes Bibblewindi 12 – 21 & 27 - 29; Bibblewindi West includes Bibblewindi 22 – 26. Bibblewindi 9 Spot includes Bibblewindi 3 – 9; Dewhurst North includes Dewhurst 6, 22 – 25; Dewhurst South includes Dewhurst 26 – 29

Decommissioning of wells:

 There are no plug and abandon activities planned for October

Workovers:

 There are no workover activities planned for October

Drilling of exploration core holes:

 There are no core hole activities planned for October

Pilot wells:

 Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst South and Tintsfield pilot wells are on-line

Leewood:

 Leewood Phase 2 water treatment plant construction is complete

Other work:

- Irrigation for rehabilitation activities is on hold following significant rainfall in Narrabri area
- The Wilga Park Power Station is on-line

- On 1 August 2016, the Land and Environment Court rejected a claim – led by the Environmental Defenders Office – that the approval for Santos' Leewood Phase 2 project was invalid. The Environmental Defenders Office, on behalf of People for the Plains has subsequently appealed this decision with the Hearing list in the Court of Appeal for early November 2016.
