SANTOS UPDATE – June 2015

Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area (PEL 238)

Time frames are indicative as schedules are dependent on factors such as approval times, weather and rig availability.

References to pilot wells are grouped in well sets as follows: Bibblewindi East includes Bibblewindi 12 – 29; Bibblewindi West includes Bibblewindi 22 – 26; Bibblewindi 9 Spot includes Bibblewindi 3 – 9; Dewhurst North includes Dewhurst 6, 22 – 25; Dewhurst South includes Dewhurst 26 – 29

Decommissioning of wells:

- There are no plug and abandon activities planned for June

Workovers:

- There are no workover activities planned for June

Drilling of exploration core holes:

- There are no core hole activities planned for June

Pilot wells:

- Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst South, Dewhurst North and Tintfield pilot wells are on-line

Leewood:

- The Review of Environmental Factors (REF) for Leewood Phase 2 was lodged with the Office of Coal Seam Gas on 20 March 2015.
