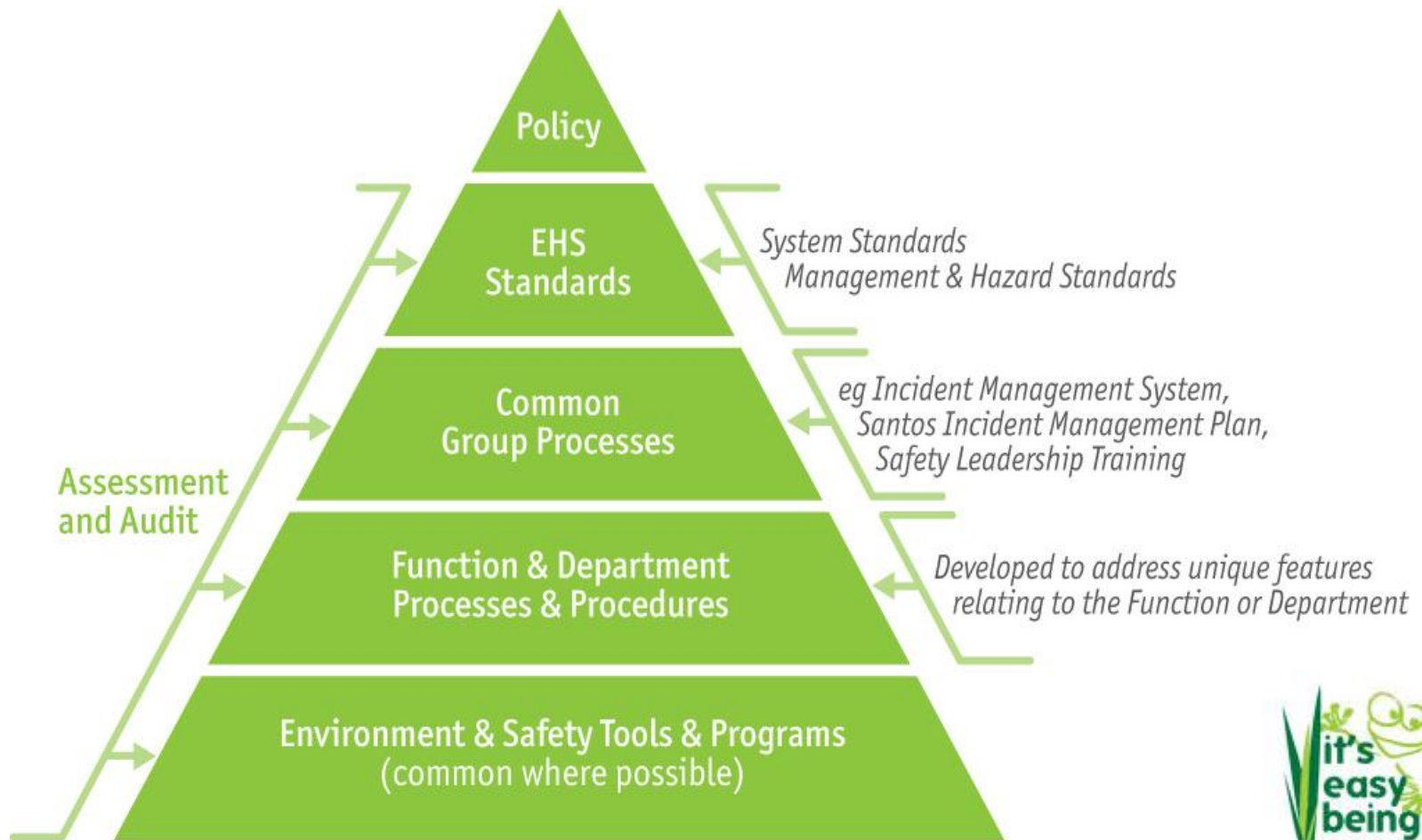
# What is the EHSMS?
