Bibblewindi 9 Spot includes Bibblewindi 3 – 9; Dewhurst North includes Dewhurst 6, 22 – 25; Dewhurst South includes Dewhurst 26 – 29

There are no plug and abandon activities planned for March

Workovers:

Drilling of exploration core holes:

 There are no core hole activities planned for March

 Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst South and Tintsfield pilot wells are on-line
