- Pond 1 (east) 23 ML
- Pond 2 (west) 92 ML




Tintsfield Ponds Timeline

- 2010 Ponds constructed by ESG
- 2011 Santos acquires ESG
- 2012 Santos commences investigations
- 2013 NSW Government notified of potential leak
- 2014 EPA becomes lead enviro regulator for all <u>CSG</u> EPL issued for Santos Narrabri EPA investigation commences
- 2015 EPA becomes lead enviro regulator for all <u>GAS</u> EPA investigation determines no environmental harm but improvements needed Pollution Study added to Narrabri EPL
- 2016 EPA remove Tintsfield PS from EPL Santos monitoring ongoing


EPA Pollution Study Findings

Pollution Study Now Concluded

- Data from new bores refines understanding of groundwater flow, chemistry
- Groundwater chemistry stable over 4+ years
- Mounding up-gradient from ponds, due to enhanced recharge
- EPA satisfied slightly elevated concentrations and mounding are result of natural landscape processes
- EPA continually reviewing data to test our conclusions
