# SANTOS UPDATE – June 2017 Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area (PEL 238)

Time frames are indicative as schedules are dependent on factors such as approval times, weather and rig availability.

References to pilot wells are grouped in well sets as follows: Bibblewindi East includes Bibblewindi 12 – 21 & 27 - 29; Bibblewindi West includes Bibblewindi 22 – 26. Bibblewindi 9 Spot includes Bibblewindi 3 – 9; Dewhurst North includes Dewhurst 6, 22 – 25; Dewhurst South includes Dewhurst 26 – 29

# **Environmental Impact Statement (EIS):**

- The public exhibition period for submissions for the Narrabri Gas Project Environmental Impact Statement ended on 22 May 2017. The Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) is collating the approx. 23,000 submissions received during the exhibition period.

### **Pilot wells:**

 Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West, Dewhurst South and Tintsfield pilot wells are on-line

#### Leewood:

 Preparations are underway to crop approximately 50 hectares at Leewood as part of the approved Leewood Produced Water Treatment and Beneficial Reuse Project

#### Other work:

- The Wilga Park Power Station is on-line
- An application for a minor modification to the project approval for the Narrabri CSG Utilisation Project has been lodged with DPE to extend the period of time that gas may be utilised from existing wells located within PAL 2 for a period of three years.
- An application for a minor modification has been lodged with the DPE to extend the operation of the existing wells approved through the Dewhurst Gas Exploration Pilot Expansion project for a further three years.
- Rehabilitation is continuing at legacy sites, including revegetation activities at Bibblewindi
- Groundwater monitoring activities for Environmental Protection Licence compliance are ongoing
