Water Expert Panel	<ul> <li>Water Expert Panel introduced, with specialities covering geology, water modelling, produced water and well integrity</li> <li>During this visit to Narrabri, Panel members have visited Santos operational sites and met with affected landholders, People for the Plains and Namoi Water</li> <li>Panel report finalised after review of Santos' response to submissions, however Panel likely to continue through assessment process and PAC may also use this panel</li> <li>General discussion around remit of the panel, the large amount of water data from various sources that should be collated, and the importance of good baseline data to give the community confidence.</li> <li>Proposed discharge into Bohena Creek and salt disposal are matters of community interest</li> <li>Discussion relating to perception by some in broader area that large parts of NSW would have gas development, for example along the pipeline route. Discussion highlighted that there is limited gas development potential in most of those areas; Santos has no on-ground activity in those areas; and DPE advised that current exploration status is minimal. Chair noted that need to have this more clearly communicated in those areas with information about actual natural gas prospectivity available.</li> <li>Chair thanked Water Panel for their time and accepting invitation to attend CCC</li> </ul>
