General Business	 Representative from People for the Plains tabled a number of questions in relation to water for RFS fire-fighting (Santos); Leewood lucerne crop (Santos); GISERA Plug and Abandoning project report (GISERA) and Plug and Abandonment Code, P&A testing and monitoring (EPA). Responses to questions will be provided to members out of session as they are finalised by relevant entities. A member requested that PFTP table their questions as being from that organization, not as being from the general community. 		

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	 A member advised the committee that there is a proposed new system for managing and conserving Aboriginal cultural heritage in NSW. The Chair advised that further information on the proposal will be provided to members out of session. Committee noted that GISERA has announced that it is partnering with the South Australian Government to conduct research into the gas industry in the Otway Basin. A member asked if the research related to onshore or offshore activities and a copy of the GISERA Fact Sheet will be distributed to members with more detail of the announcement. A member advised that she had heard the GISERA health study was not continuing. Another member advised that the first phase of the project was complete and further phases of research were subject to normal GISERA research approval processes. Committee noted that the Geological Survey of NSW has released updated data for the Coonabarabran geophysical data project. A summary of that project will be provided to members and a link to the DRG newsletter will be distributed. Chair encouraged members in December 2017 to their respective organisations. The report provides information about the geology of the Coonamble-Gilgandra region and also assists in responding to topical matters in relation to the Western Slopes Pipeline project.
