# Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area (PEL 238)

## **Environmental Impact Statement (EIS):**

- Santos submitted our detailed response to submissions (RTS) on the EIS to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) in April 2018.
- DPE has requested further information from Santos to inform their assessment of the EIS.

# **Western Slopes Pipeline:**

- The submission of the EIS for the APA Group Western Slopes Pipeline is dependent on the timing of the Narrabri Gas Project EIS assessment.
- APA Group announced in October 2018 that it has deferred submission of the EIS for the Western Slopes Pipeline until the assessment of the Narrabri Gas Project EIS has further progressed.

# Drilling of exploration core holes, workovers and decommissioning of wells:

• No activities planned for January.

#### **Pilot wells:**

- Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West and Dewhurst South pilot wells are online.
- Tintsfield pilot is off-line to reduce flaring until additional gas is required.

### Leewood:

- Santos does not need to irrigate at this time and all water is stored in our state of the art water holding ponds at Leewood.
- Santos' request for the withdrawal of the EPA penalty infringement notice relating to Leewood irrigation was unsuccessful.

#### Other work:

 Construction of the gas flowline from the Dewhurst South pilot wells to connect to the existing gathering network has been completed. This flowline enables gas from these wells to be used in the Wilga Park Power Station to generate power for the region and will substantially reduce flaring.

- The Wilga Park Power Station will be on-line following completion of the flowline project and annual generator maintenance. The facility will be producing up to 16 megawatts per hour or 140,160 MWh annually which is the equivalent of powering more than 23,000 average households in NSW.
- Rehabilitation is continuing at legacy sites, including revegetation activities at Bibblewindi.
