Proposed upcoming work program – Narrabri Area (PEL 238)

Environmental Impact Statement (EIS):

- The Narrabri Gas Project EIS, response to submissions (RTS) and supplementary RTS have been submitted to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE).
- Assessment of the project is continuing through the State Significant Development planning framework.

Western Slopes Pipeline:

- APA Group announced in October 2018 that it has deferred submission of the EIS for the Western Slopes Pipeline until the assessment of the Narrabri Gas Project EIS has further progressed.

- Tintsfield pilot is offline to reduce flaring until additional gas is required.

Leewood:

 Santos does not need to irrigate at this time and all water is stored in our state of the art water holding ponds at Leewood.

Wilga Park Power Station:

- The Wilga Park Power Station is online.
- Work is continuing on the commissioning of two new generators.

Other Activities:

 Groundwater monitoring activities for Environmental Protection Licence compliance are ongoing.

- Santos has donated \$600,000 to emergency relief and recovery efforts to assist communities impacted by recent bushfires, including \$300,000 to the South Australian Government's Bushfire Appeal, \$250,000 to Lifeline Australia's Community Recovery Program and \$50,000 to Adelaide Koala Rescue.

- On 30 January 2020, Santos, and its Cooper Basin joint venture partner Beach Energy announced the extension of ethane gas supply to Qenos, Australia's sole manufacturer of polyethylene and leading supplier of world-class polymers. The sixyear gas contract will enable Qenos to maintain its operations at Botany Bay in Sydney and secure over 500 jobs associated with its NSW activities.
