## Santos

### Narrabri Gas Project (PEL 238)



#### **Environmental Impact Statement (EIS):**

- On 30 September 2020, the NSW Independent Planning Commission (IPC) approved the Narrabri Gas Project following detailed deliberations, with the Commission concluding that the Project is in the public interest and that any negative impacts can be effectively mitigated with strict conditions. - On 24 November 2020, the Federal Minister for the Environment Sussan Ley approved the project under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC) following her review of the New South Wales assessment. No activities planned for December.

#### Pilot wells:

- Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West and Dewhurst South pilot wells are online. Tintsfield pilot is offline.
- Routine pump maintenance activities are continuing with the use of a workover rig on existing wells at Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West and Dewhurst South. This work is being conducted under existing approvals.

#### Leewood:

 Santos does not need to irrigate at this time and water is stored in the holding ponds at Leewood.

#### Wilga Park Power Station:

• The Wilga Park Power Station is online.

#### **Other Activities:**

- Spring ecological surveys and annual ecological monitoring activities are being undertaken at a number of locations during December.
- Groundwater monitoring activities for Environmental Protection Licence compliance are ongoing.

#### Community:

- A condition of the IPC consent for the Narrabri Gas Project is the establishment and operation of a Community Consultative Committee in accordance with the Department's Community Consultative Committee Guidelines: State Significant Projects and also a number of advisory groups including a Biodiversity Advisory Group and a Water Technical Advisory Group.
- The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment has advised that Mr Garry West has been appointed to the position of Independent Chair of these groups. Mr West has requested that an Expression of Interest be advertised for community and stakeholder representatives with nominations for these positions closing on 22 December 2020.
