Environmental Impact Statement (EIS):

Other:

- On 30 March 2021, Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer Kevin Gallagher announced that Santos, as operator of the Barossa joint venture, had taken a final investment decision (FID) to proceed with the US\$3.6 billion gas and condensate project, located offshore the Northern Territory. Barossa FID also kick-starts the US\$600 million investment in the Darwin LNG life extension and pipeline tie-in projects, which will extend the facility life for around 20 years. The Santos-operated Darwin LNG plant has the capacity to produce approximately 3.7 million tonnes of LNG per annum.
