Narrabri Gas Project (PEL 238)



Environmental Impact Statement (EIS):

Western Slopes Pipeline:

- The APA Group is continuing to work with Santos on the development of the Western Slopes Pipeline project to connect the natural gas from the Narrabri Gas Project to homes and businesses across New South Wales. - Bibblewindi East, Bibblewindi West and Dewhurst South pilot wells are online. Tintfield pilot is offline.

Leewood:

- Santos does not need to irrigate at this time and water is stored in the holding ponds at Leewood.

Wilga Park Power Station:

- The Wilga Park Power Station is online.

Other Activities:

- Seasonal ecological surveys are being undertaken during May.

- Groundwater monitoring activities for Environmental Protection Licence compliance are ongoing.
