Project Approvals:

- On 21 July 2020, the NSW Government released its Future
 of Gas Statement, outlining plans for the gas industry in
 NSW, while ruling out gas production under the majority of
 Petroleum Exploration Licences with the exception of
 those which support the future of the Narrabri Gas Project.

- On 20 July, Santos advised the market that it had submitted a confidential, non-binding indicative all-scrip merger proposal to the Oil Search Board with the transaction implemented through a Scheme of Arrangement. On 2 August 2021, Santos and Oil Search reached agreement on the merger ratio under the proposed merger. Both parties have committed to conduct best endeavours due diligence subject to appropriate confidentiality arrangements over a period of approximately four weeks with the aim of entering into a Merger Implementation Agreement.
