Project Approvals:

- On 30 September 2020, the NSW Independent Planning Commission (IPC) approved the Narrabri Gas Project. Further information on the IPC decision and a copy of the Development Consent is available at www.ipcn.nsw.gov.au/projects/2020/03/narrabri-gasproject

Other Activities:

 Annual ecological surveys and monitoring activities are being undertaken during October. • Groundwater monitoring activities for Environmental Protection Licence compliance are ongoing.

- Santos and Oil Search have entered into a definitive agreement to merge the two companies in an all-scrip transaction. The Merger is subject to a limited number of customary conditions including Oil Search shareholder approval, regulatory approvals and Papua New Guinea court approval, with an implementation date of 16 December 2021 if conditions are met.
