Narrabri Gas Project (PEL 238)



Project Approvals:

Leewood:

- Santos does not need to irrigate at this time and water is stored in the holding ponds at Leewood.
- Recent heavy rain conditions have not impacted the ponds and water levels are within design capacity.

Wilga Park Power Station:

• The Wilga Park Power Station is online.

Other Activities:

 Groundwater monitoring activities for Environmental Protection Licence compliance are ongoing.

Community:

Other:

- Santos is partnering with CSIRO to develop what is hoped could become the lowest cost direct air capture technology in the world. The collaboration will continue to develop CSIRO Carbon Assist™ technology which removes CO2 directly from the atmosphere and higher-concentration post-combustion scenarios that can then be safely stored or used to make carbon-based products.
